Features


Sensitivity 92.9% (13/14) vs. RT-PCR

Limit of Detection 1.97 x 10⁴ TCID₅₀/ml

No Cross-reactivity with other feline pathogens (FCV, FeLV, FPV, E. coli, Giardia, and Salmonella)
