

Feline parvovirus (FPV) is a nasty feline virus that attacks the guts, immune system, and heart. FPV often causes severe illness (e.g., feline panleukopenia and feline infectious enteritis) and sometimes the death of cats.

The RIDXTM FPV Ag Test Kit is a diagnostic reagent that can quickly and easily detect FPV antigen in feline feces 10 minutes after dropping the sample.


